Who can Tino help:

- British Nationals
- Other European nationals

Tino CAN:

- Help provide appropriate support if you are a victim of crime, have suffered rape or serious assault, are ill or in hospital.
- Offer support and help in a range of other situations, such as death of a relative overseas, missing people, child abduction and kidnapping
- Contact you if you have been detained and offer help in contacting family or friends if you want.
- Pass you details of local lawyers, interpreters, doctors and funeral directors including information about transferring funds

In the future (late 2012/early 2013) Tino should also be able to provide limited notarial services such as:

- Certification of signatures and certified copies of certain documents
- Assistance in providing a document if you need to travel in an emergency and do not have your full validity passport

Tino CANNOT:

- Get involved in private disputes over property, employment or commercial matters
- Pay any bills or give you money from public funds
- Give you legal advice or investigate crimes
- Get you out of prison or interfere in criminal or civil court proceedings
